Subject: Conflict Minerals Declaration

To Whom It May Concern,

In July 2010, The United States Congress signed into law the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Regulation and Consumer Protection Act containing a section that regulates conflict minerals. (Section 1502)

Section 1502 requires companies that make products for which 4 minerals (tantalum, tin, tungsten and gold) are necessary to the functionality or production of the product to assess their supply chains and publically report on the source of these minerals if they are sourced from Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) or adjoining country.

In 2017, Regulation (EU) 2017/821 of the European Parliament and of the European Council of 17 May 2017 was passed concerning supply chain due diligence obligations for Union importers of Tin, Tantalum and Tungsten, their ores, and gold originating from conflict-affected and high risk areas.

Klemsan Company complies with all National and Global applicable regulations and as we Klemsan Company, hereby we declare that Klemsan products don't originate in the DRC or the adjoining countries at issue.

Klemsan has been following the revision history of CMRT "Conflict Mineral Reporting Template" and this declaration has been prepared and issued according to Revision 6.5 of CMRT.
