AGRO is aware that EU Directives 2011/65/EU and 2015/863/EU restrict the use of certain substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

This relates to the following substances:

- Lead
- Mercury
- Cadmium
- Hexavalent chromium
- PBB
- PBDE
- Flame retardants and plasticizers: DEHP, BBP, DBP and DIBP

Based on information provided by our suppliers and our current state of knowledge, we can make the following statement:

The content of the above-mentioned substances in our products, apart from as covered by Exemption a), does not exceed the limits specified in the RoHS Directive.

a) Lead as an alloying element in our brass cable glands and brass accessories

For categories 1 to 7 and 10, exemption 6c Annex III applies until 21st July 2021, following which a reassessment will be carried out. For all other categories, the current exemption will continue to apply during the period of validity set out in Article 5 (2) of Directive 2011/65/EU.

Supplemental information and findings shall be considered by us and periodically included in our assessment. AGRO uses state-of-the-art materials and processes in its product development work, and takes ongoing developments into account.
